Sustainability (waste)

JPCDL is committed to ensuring consistent good environmental performance through due diligence and programmes of continual improvement review; it has adopted an integrated approach in its operational activities, aiming to take into consideration the protection of the environment as a whole and employs cost effective environmental management into all aspects of the organisation's activities. The Company recognises its obligations to reduce or control the effects of its environmental impacts particularly in the areas of efficient use of resources, waste disposal & energy usage. Furthermore through diligently ensuring compliance with environmental legislation, the Company is committed to monitoring and aspiring to improve its principles of organisational environmental sustainability performance.

- a) The construction of the code level 4 property in Northway, Bishopston, Swansea requires JPCDL to complete a Site Waste Management Plan (SWMP) with the aim to minimise waste during construction. The objective is that 85% of all waste is diverted from landfill. JPCDL has signed up to WRAP and has provided a SWMP that identifies waste streams, forecasts waste, records any waste reductions and all recovery actions. The aim as already stated is to reduce waste by 85%. The SWMP is available on request (many pages long) as this questionnaire limits to 1 A4 side only.
